Hours of work are negotiable, with an on-call commitment (approximately 1 in 4 weekends and one evening each week). We would also consider a fixed-term appointment or a permanent placement.

General medical experience and an interest in palliative care are required. Qualifications in palliative care would be desirable but are not essential as appropriate supervision and ongoing support will be provided.
