Duties/Abilities

An opportunity has become available for a Senior Staff Specialist or Staff Specialist (Palliative Medicine) to join Gold Coast Health (GCH) where the focus of our 9000-strong team is on providing world-class health care to over 550,000 people living in the Gold Coast, and northern New South Wales region.

About the role

Provide specialist palliative care services within the Gold Coast Hospital and Health Service (GCHHS) to patients as part of a multidisciplinary team to ensure the provision of appropriate patient care. In addition, provide professional leadership within a specialist medical area and provide training, education and supervision to medical students from universities, junior medical staff and other health care providers.

Requirements for the role

- It is a condition of employment in this role for the employee to be, and remain, vaccinated against the following vaccine preventable diseases during their employment: measles, mumps, rubella, varicella (chicken pox), pertussis (whooping cough), hepatitis B.
- MBBS or equivalent registrable with the Medical Board of Australia plus FACHPM or equivalent acceptable to the Royal Australasian College of Physicians and registrable as a Palliative Medicine Specialist with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).
- Relevant qualification/s and registration must be provided to the appropriate supervisor/manager, prior to the commencement of clinical duties.
- The incumbent will be required to provide after-hours palliative care input on a rostered basis including overnights and weekends.
