## Staff Specialist in Palliative Care Medicine - Apply via eCredential

Applications are invited from suitably qualified medical practitioners eligible for registration in New South Wales for the above position within the Department of Palliative Care, Central Coast Local Health District CCLHD.

**Applicants should be a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians and / or other specialist recognition as provided for in the Staff Specialist (State) Award. The Central Coast Palliative Care Service provides inpatient consultation services to Gosford and Wyong Hospital, a community consultation service to patients at home or in residential aged care facilities and an inpatient palliative care unit is planned to open in 2021. It is desirable that specialists are flexible and can work across all locations as required.**

Central Coast is comprised of the twin areas of Gosford and Wyong, positioned between Sydney and Newcastle, which are collectively expected to grow from the current approximate 300,000 to 450,000 population before 2030. The Local Health District has strong connections with both Royal North Shore Hospital and the University of Newcastle.
