The incumbent will provide supportive and educative Palliative Care services including medical services to inpatients and outpatients of NALHN including patients in community outreach programs within the NALHN catchment area and also contribute to and supervise staff development and training, policy planning and research, also contribute to and supervise the teaching of medical undergraduates and graduates which contributes to the achievement of the goals and objectives of NALHN.

It is an essential requirement of this position that applicants have a Bachelor of Medicine; Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) or equivalent, and an appropriate specialist qualification (Fellowship of the Australasian Chapter of Palliative Medicine or equivalent) and registrable with the Medical Board of Australia as a Medical Practitioner with Specialist registration.
