Website

For up to three months (for 'Positions Vacant' – one free per position advertised). The advertisement will be removed from ANZSPM's website one week after the application closing date, but you may re-advertise at no extra cost any time within the three month period.

\$270 AUD (+ GST for Australian clients- i.e \$297 AUD)

Advertising Terms and Conditions

1. All copy for advertisements is subject to the approval of ANZSPM, who reserve the right to decline or cancel any advertisement, even if ordered and paid for without stating any reasons therefore, and/or make modifications necessary to any advertisement to maintain the publication's standards.
2. ANZSPM will only advertise substantive positions where the employer has been identified on its jobs board.
3. Advertisements must be cancelled in writing and can only be cancelled up to 10 days prior to publication of the newsletter. All cancellations will incur a 20% cancellation fee. This fee becomes payable immediately on receipt of the cancellation instruction.
4. Every effort will be made to avoid errors, but no responsibility will be accepted for any mistakes that may arise in the course of publication of any advertisement. These mistakes are taken to include non-insertion, insertions other than those ordered and errors and omissions within the advertisement. ANZSPM accepts no responsibility for slight variations in colour on advertisements.
5. No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage to copy, artwork or photographs supplied.
6. Advertisers must ensure that the content of the advertisement complies with all legal requirements.
